Phyllis Bennis a fellow at the Institute for Policy Studies in Washington DC, specializing in Middle East and United Nations issues. She is an acclaimed author of many books and articles, international affairs analyst and activist. Bennis’ most recent publication is: *Challenging Empire: How People, Governments, and the UN Defy US Power, 2005*. While working as a journalist at the United Nations during the run-up to the 1990-91 Gulf War, she began working on U.S. domination of the UN, and stayed involved in work on Iraq sanctions and disarmament, and later U.S. war and occupation in Iraq. In 1999 she made international headlines by analyzing US-led sanctions on the civilian population. Phyllis is frequently published in the Baltimore Sun, Middle East International, Middle East Report (MERIP), TomPaine.com, Mother Jones and many other publications. She appears regularly in U.S. and international media, including Democracy Now!
